Managing Passwords in Firefox

- 1. Click on the menu button \equiv to open the menu panel.
 - 2. Click Passwords. The Firefox about: logins page will open in a new tab.



From here, you can view, copy, edit or remove your saved logins.

Note: You can enter a site, username or password in the *Search logins* text box, to filter the logins listed on the left.

After you select an entry from the list of logins, you can perform these actions:

- Click Copy to copy a username or password.
- Click **(**) to see the password.
- Click Edit to change the username or password.
- Click **Remove** to remove the login from Firefox.
